Class 3 - Native/ M&M
Open to all native breeds, pure or part bred. Judged on type & way of going.

Class 4 - Best Rescue
All proceeds of this class to S.A.F.E.
Class to be judged on points basis-
rescue story (up to 10 points) transformation (up to 10 points) manners & way of going (up to 20 points)
Please bring along a picture for the transformation score.

Class 5 - Riding Club Horse/Pony
To be judged on suitability to perform a range of Riding Club abilities, Inhand horses will be judged on manners, correctness of gait & overall conformation.

Class 6 - Family Horse/Pony

Class to be judged on overall suitability as a family mount & companion.

Class 7 - Almost Bus Pass
Special rosette to oldest horse in this class
